II. PRE-JUNIOR SCHOLARSHIPS

The first two years of college lay the basis of tools and background for the later specialization. At the close of the sophomore year, the Pre-junior Achievement Tests are given. On the basis of this record, Ten Pre-junior Scholarships are awarded to the five boys and five girls making the highest all round records. These awards cannot be determined until all grades are in, hence will be announced at the August Commencement Exercises.

III. SENIOR CLASS SCHOLARSHIPS

Rewards for faithful and scholarly achievement are provided for the members of the senior class each year as fully as is possible, and according to the practical opportunities. In some cases, assistance is given in securing Scholarships or Fellowships in Graduate Schools elsewhere; in other cases, appointments are made to Fellowships or Scholarships in the Graduate School of Texas Christian University, on the basis of the fitness for the work in some particular department.

As reward for high grade work, Scholarships of \$150.00 for the Graduate School of Texas Christian University for the session of 1932-33, are awarded to all of the students who have attained the honor of *summa cum laude*.
