JEROME A. MOORE (Fort Worth) — Honorary Doctor of Laws Degree. Dean of TCU AddRan College of Arts and Sciences and professor of Spanish since 1943, beginning 26th year of service in September, 1968, the longest period anyone has served as a TCU dean; chairman of department of foreign languages (1945-58), director of study committee since 1943, member of numerous committees and University Council; long family association with TCU, father-in-law attended AddRan College (forerunner of TCU) at Thorp Spring, Texas; active in many educational organizations and associations, serving as past president of Texas Council of Church Related Colleges and The Association of Texas Colleges, former member of executive committee of Southern Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools; past president of Fort Worth Good Neighbor Council, past president of Fort Worth Chapter of International Good Neighbor Council, member of Southern Association Committee on Latin American Relations, past Honorary Consul of Mexico in Fort Worth and Tarrant County, honorary life member of the Good Neighbor Commission of Texas; member of Fort Worth Rotary Club; organizer and former minister of Jewella Christian Church (now Fair Park Christian Church) in Shreveport, Louisiana; secretary of the TCU Board of Trustees since 1947; graduate of Texas Christian University, Ph.D. from University of Pennsylvania, with special studies at University of Texas, University of Paris, and University of Geneva; honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree from University of the Americas in 1963.

A. D. WEATHERLY (Amarillo) — Honorary Doctor of Laws Degree. Member of the TCU Board of Trustees since 1949 and of Brite Divinity School, TCU; interests in ranching, oil and gas, and banking; member of board of directors of Producers Chemical Co., American National Bank of Amarillo, and Panhandle-Plains Historical Society; president of Panhandle Producers and Royalty Owners Association; council member of High Plains Hospital Development Fund; life member of Boys Ranch; member of Texas Mid-Continent Oil and Gas Association, Independent Petroleum Association, New Mexico Cattle Growers Association, and Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association; past member of Des Moines, New Mexico, School Board; past chairman of the board of First Christian Church, Amarillo; Mason and Shriner; graduate of Texas Christian University.
