JOHN M. GRIMLAND, JR.

Midland

Honorary Doctor of Laws Degree

A Certified Public Accountant, Mr. Grimland headed his own company before merging with the national accounting firm of Main LaFrentz in 1968. The Clifton (Tex.) native graduated from TCU with a Bachelor of Science in Commerce degree in 1939 and has been a member of the University's Board of Trustees since 1972.

A well-known civic leader in Midland, he headed the Chamber of Commerce in 1977 and the United Fund in 1969, was president of the Industrial Foundation, and has been an officer of the Metropolitan Board of the YMCA. He also has been president of the Midland Symphony and Chorus Association Inc. and of the Midland Estate Council.

Mr. Grimland is a charter member and former president of the Optimist Club in Midland, serving as District 7 governor and as international president in 1962-63. A member of the executive committee of Midland Memorial Hospital, he has served as a director of the Boys Ranch of West Texas and treasurer of High Sky Girls Ranch.

Active in the Texas Society of CPA's, Mr. Grimland was presented its distinguished service award in 1970. He is past-president of the Permian Basin Chapter of the Texas Society and is a member of the American Institute of CPA's. An active member of First United Methodist Church in Midland, he has served on its educational and finance committees and chaired its board of trustees. Long active in the TCU Alumni Association, Mr. Grimland was its international president in 1965-66. In that position he participated in ceremonies for the inauguration of Dr. Moudy as TCU's chancellor in November, 1965.

DR. JAMES M. MOUDY

Fort Worth

Honorary Doctor of Letters Degree

Chancellor of Texas Christian University, Dr. Moudy has been involved in higher education since he entered TCU as a freshman in 1939, with the exception of a World War II overseas tour as an Army chaplain. Born in Harlingen, he lived in Greenville before moving with his mother and brother to Washington, D.C., where he was graduated from McKinley Technical High School. For six years he was employed by the U. S. Treasury Department before enrolling in TCU where he received the B.A. degree "with distinction" in 1943 and the Bachelor of Divinity degree through Brite Divinity School in 1949. While working on that degree he was assistant minister at University Christian Church and then was minister at the A & M Christian Church in College Station for two years. In 1953 he received the Ph.D. degree at Duke University, where he was a Kearns Fellow and named Phi Beta Kappa.

Dr. Moudy was dean of instruction at Atlantic Christian College until his return to TCU in 1957 as professor of religion and dean of The Graduate School. He assumed supervision of all scholastic work as vice chancellor for academic affairs in 1962 and was named executive vice chancellor in 1964. He was inaugurated as chancellor in 1965, the seventh person to head the University which was founded in 1873.

In 1969-71, Dr. Moudy was moderator of the General Assembly of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), the denomination with which TCU is related. Previously he had served as president of the North Carolina Convention of Christian Churches, and a two-year term as chairman of the Board of Higher Education of the Disciples of Christ.

A founder and former president of the Independent Colleges and Universities of Texas Inc. (ICUT), he chaired the National Council of Independent Colleges and Universities in 1975. He has been honored as Fort Worth's Outstanding Citizen of the Year by the Exchange Club and was named Paul Harris Fellow of the Rotary Club of Fort Worth.

Dr. Moudy is a member of numerous academic and civic organizations as well as the Newcomen Society in North America and the Philosophical Society of Texas. He serves on several boards of directors, including the Fort Worth Chamber of Commerce, Jarvis Christian College, Interuniversity Council and Board of Governing Participants of TAGER (The Association for Graduate Education and Research of North Texas).
