BACCALAUREATE HONORS RECOGNITION

Students having a cumulative grade point average of 3.9 or above on a 4.0 scale are graduated Summa Cum Laude; those with 3.7 to 3.9 are graduated Magna Cum Laude; those with 3.5 to 3.7 are graduated Cum Laude.

Students with the requisite grade point average who have completed with distinction Honors work in the major field of study including a Senior Honors Project are recognized as having attained Departmental Honors. Those who complete an interdisciplinary Senior Honors Project involving more than one major field of study receive Interdepartmental Honors. Those with the requisite grade point average who have completed, with distinction, the four interdisciplinary Honors Colloquia are recognized as having attained University Honors.
