Our Executive Committee held a meeting this week and set the price for the 1946 Season Boxes. The posted prices on box tickets will be the same in 1946 as they were in 1945 — \$3.00 per ticket plus 20% Federal Tax — Total price per ticket, \$3.60. The net price for 1946 box tickets will be \$2.25 per ticket plus 20% Federal Tax  $(45\phi)$ , total \$2.70 per seat. With few exceptions, the boxes have 6 and 8 seats each. By buying a box for the season there will be a savings of \$102.60 for a 6 seat box and \$136.80 for an 8 seat box. These figures are based on the following:


