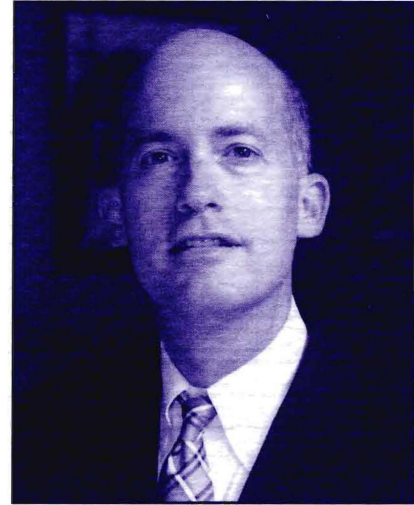

CHANCELLOR VICTOR J. BOSCHINI, JR.

Victor J. Boschini, Jr. assumed office as Texas Christian University's tenth Chancellor on June 1, 2003. He also holds the rank of professor of education.

Chancellor Boschini came to TCU after serving as president of Illinois State University from 1999 to 2003. At Illinois State, he also was associate professor in the educational administration and foundations department in the College of Education and taught a class each semester throughout his presidency. In addition, Chancellor Boschini was a member of the board of directors of the Illinois Campus Compact, a coalition of college and university presidents committed to helping students develop the values and skills of citizenship through participation in public and community service. From 1997 to 1999, Chancellor Boschini served as Illinois State's vice president for student affairs.



Prior to coming to Illinois State, he was associate provost at Butler University in Indianapolis, Indiana, and also taught in Butler's College of Education. Chancellor Boschini previously spent eight years at Indiana University in various administrative posts, as well as teaching in the university's School of Education.

Chancellor Boschini earned a bachelor's degree from Mount Union College in 1978. He was awarded a master's degree in personnel from Bowling Green State University in 1979 and a doctorate in higher education administration from Indiana University in 1989.

FACULTY TEACHING AND RESEARCH OR CREATIVITY AWARDS

Brittan Teaching Award

Dr. Kenneth Cracknell, professor of theology and global studies, is the recipient of the Louise Clark Brittan Endowed Teaching Award. This \$3,000 award is given by the Brite Divinity School student body to recognize superlative teaching performance.

Hill Faculty Award

Dr. Joseph R. Jeter, Jr. is the recipient of the Catherine Saylor Hill Endowed Faculty Excellence Award given by the Brite Divinity School faculty to recognize excellence in teaching, scholarship and service. It is an award for \$3,000. Dr. Jeter is the Granville and Erline Walker Professor of Homiletics and also is director of the Ph.D. program at Brite.

Piper Professor Award

Dr. Donald W. Jackson, Herman Brown Professor of Political Science, has been selected a Piper Professor of 2003. There are fifteen awards of \$5,000 each, given annually by the Minnie Stevens Piper Foundation to Texas professors for superior teaching at the college level.

Deans' Research or Creativity Award

This \$2,500 award is presented to three faculty members who have produced the highest quality research or creative activity over the last several years. Each college/school is eligible to submit one nominee with AddRan College being eligible to submit two nominees, one each from the Humanities and Social Sciences areas. All nominees must have been a full-time tenured or tenure track faculty member at TCU for a minimum of five years and their research/creative activity must have been recognized nationally or internationally.

Deans' Teaching Award

This award is presented to three faculty members voted on by their peers for dedicated teaching. Nominees must have been a full-time faculty member at TCU for a minimum of five years and must have shown a particular dedication to teaching and teaching-related activities. Each college/school is eligible to submit one nominee with AddRan College being eligible to submit two nominees, one each from the Humanities and Social Sciences areas. Each recipient receives \$2,500.

THE FLAGS

The twenty-three flags displayed on the arena floor represent the countries of our thirty-eight international students who are receiving their diplomas today. The following countries are represented: Bahrain, Bosnia/Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, China, Colombia, Guatemala, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Jamaica, Japan, Kenya, Korea, Malaysia, Mexico, Russian Federation, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Turkey, United Kingdom and Viet Nam.

THE MACE

The mace is a symbol of the strength of a university. In Medieval times, the mace was a weapon designed to protect the dignitary in a procession. Academia borrowed that tradition from royalty, designating it as a symbol of the power of a university and of its leader – power shared with the faculty. Maces, similar in appearance to ancestral weaponry, usually are constructed of wood or metal and may have symbols of the institution worked into the design. TCU's mace was created to commemorate the inauguration of Chancellor Michael R. Ferrari. TCU staff member, Robert Kramer, a master carver, made the shaft of the mace. It is fashioned from a wooden beam from the first building constructed at Add-Ran Male and Female College in Thorp Spring, Texas. The head of the mace was created by international sculptor and TCU parent, Seppo Aarnos, and proudly bears the horned frog, adopted in 1897 as the University's mascot. An amethyst at the center of the head glows with the colors purple for royalty and white for purity.

TRADITION OF ACADEMIC DRESS

The history of academic dress dates from at least the twelfth century, when long gowns were needed for warmth in the unheated buildings used by medieval scholars. In England, both Oxford and Cambridge made academic dress a matter of university surveillance, and both institutions regulated which colors and trim could be used by faculty and students. In May 1895, representatives from American institutions of higher learning met at Columbia University and formulated a "code of academic dress" which has generally been followed since that time, although some revisions were initiated in 1932 and in 1960.

The dress code recommended that gowns for the bachelor's degree should be worn closed and should have pointed sleeves. Gowns for the master's degree can be worn open or closed, but their sleeves are oblong in shape with open wrists. Gowns worn by those holding the doctoral degree also can be worn open or closed and feature bell shaped sleeves.

Gowns from different institutions vary in color, but most are black. Neither the bachelors' nor the masters' gowns feature trim, but doctoral gowns are faced down the front with black velvet and hold three bars of the same fabric across the sleeves. Sometimes these facings and sleeve-bars are velvet of the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains, thus agreeing in color with the binding or edging of the hood appropriate to the particular doctoral degree of the wearer.

Hoods are to be of the same color and material as the gowns and are lined with the official color(s) of the college or university conferring the degree. Bindings or edgings for the hoods display the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. Bachelors' hoods are three feet in length; masters' hoods are three and one-half feet in length; doctoral hoods measure four feet in length.

For all academic purposes, including the trimmings of gowns, hoods, and tassels, the colors associated with the different academic fields are as follows:
