On Christmas day they were shelling us with two little pieces. After that they did not interrupt us any more. We had two men by the name of Burny and Davis killed in our co., and two wounded by the name of Ditto and Baye and two Burny and Peoples surrendered and one missing by the name of Renfro.

It is getting late and I have to write by a ~~fire~~ light wood fire so I will have to close my letter soon.

We are all in good health Pete is unhurt all the limestone boys come out safe.

Benn Kennedy is here. His wound is not entirely well yet he says Joe Barker is doing well = he is at an excellent place in Alabama. Ben is going to try to try to get a furlough and come home = Joe will do the same when he gets able to come to the Regt. I have not still heard anything from Gye I hope there is nothing the matter with him that we cannot ~~hear~~ hear of him:

I would like to hear from Jim when you write:

Give my love to all the family and relations and all enquiring friends and to your selves reserve my best affections. Give my special love to Father and mother

With these hasty and badly
written lines I remain your brother
Sam. N. B. I had like to have
forgot to say a happy new-year and don't
know if it is not a mockery to say it when
a desolating war is all over our land ruining
the country and killing its thousand
daily and perhaps causing tears to flow from
the eyes of many mothers and sisters and
wives and lovers, on account of the loved ones
lost in this most cruel of all wars waged
by an unrelenting foe for the purpose of
conquest and empire.

I will say but little on this subject,
but God grant that there may be a peace
soon so that both friend and foe may go
home and enjoy themselves in peace and plen-
ty. But if the Eng. will have war they
can have it to the bloody end for we are
determined to fight them until all our
means are exhausted and every man killed
before we will submit to their tyrannical
rule. I will now have to close. Send this
to Dean as soon as you get it.
