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Calls For the Resignation of Amon G. Carter

Austin, Nov. 30.—A new angle was injected into the fight between the administration and the anti-administration today when Governor Ferguson called for the resignation from the board of directors of the Texas Technological college at Lubbock of Amon G. Carter, publisher and owner of the Fort Worth Star-Telegram. Carter had no statement to make this time, but will answer later.
