Amon Carter and Son Are Reunited

AT THE 83RD DIVISION COMMAND POST, Germany, May 5. (AP)—Lt. Amon G. Carter, Jr., a prisoner of the Germans since Faid Pass, Tunisia, more than two two years ago, was reunited here today with his father, publisher of the Fort Worth Star-Telegram. Carter Sr., is making a tour of the front after visiting atrocity scenes.

Young Carter's first words were "Here I am dad." He promptly started figuring out how to get his buddies out of Luckenwalde prison, from which he was liberated by a special patrol sent to get him in time for the reunion.

Overcoming visible embarrassment before the part of army personnel and press representatives, he kept saying not only to his father but to the general officers present:

"We've got to go back and get those other fellows. They're worried about the Russian-German fights going on all around them and we've got to get them."
