EAST OF THE ELBE WITH
THE RUSSIAN ARMIES, May 2
(AP).—Three released American
prisoners of war from Lucken-
walde reported today that a Fort
Worth publisher's son, Lt. Amon
G. Carter, was alive and well and
had been liberated by the Russians.

"Carter was distributing Red
Cross parcels and when I saw
him last yesterday, he was in
good shape and was staying in
the camp until arrangements
could be made for him," said Lt.
Henry N. Crellin, of Springfield,
