Dear Sir:

I thank you for your letter of May 24th and the information therein about the locality and finding of these meteorites.

I got your invoice in triplicate all right and have submitted one copy to Maher and Company, World Trade Center, Houston, Texas, 77002, who are handling the matter there for Parr, Leon and Hayhoe. I have paid them the C. O. D. charge of Parr, Leon and Hayhoe of \$89.37, which I presume is for freight, handling and insurance up to the time the shipment was loaded. I have also paid \$28.40 for the ocean freight, collect.

I have not yet paid your invoice because I am waiting to hear why the shipment is shown as only 964 pounds when you billed it as 1370 pounds gross and 1280 net.

When this is all cleared up I will let you know about the additional meteorite you have kindly offered me.
