My dear Mr. Carter:



I happened to be in Houston the early part of the week when the announcement came out in the Houston paper and I heard quite a bit of comment in the lobby of the Rice Hotel as to how happy those individuals were who express themselves and whom I did not know in regard to the whereabouts of Amon Jr.

He has proved himself not only a credit to his Dad but to the Nation as a whole and it is too bad that a young man of his caliber has to be kept in a prisoner camp for the duration whereas he could be out on the firing line doing justice to our enemy as he was doing when captured.
