Dear Mrs. Ziegler:

In going through an accumulation of papers on Mr. Carter's desk I found your letter of February 18th enclosing a card from your son who is a prisoner of war in Germany, which I know you want to keep and am, therefore, returning it.

If we could only get something definite all of us would feel better I am sure. Mr. Carter has been in communication with a number of the boys who were liberated or escaped but all of their reports are so conflicting that we know no more than originally.

Mr. Carter received a card from his son April 7th which was dated February 7th and written from Stalag III A at Luckenwalde about 30 miles south of Berlin. From all indications the members of Oflag 64 when evacuated from Ebnubin were split up into two or three groups and sent to various places, and may still be on the move.
