Dear Sir:

We have just received your letter of June 4th., with instructions to turn the plaster model of the Will Rogers Memorial statue, to Mrs. Louise Raymond, of this city, and will proceed to do so without delay.

Our reason for questioning the authority of Mrs. Raymond arose from the fact that we had at no time been shown any authorization over your signature, and that we had not received any letter to that effect previous to this date.

To further complicate matters, the only truck that called for the model, belonged, not to any storage warehouse, but to one of the bronze foundries in this section. That is, to a competitor whose storage would be no more fire-proof than our own.
