

Midway 'Neutrality' Violated, Says Dallas

DALLAS, Sept. 8 (AP).—Relocation of the administration building at Midway Airport, proposed by Commerce Secretary Jones, would violate the neutrality of the port, Mayor Woodall Rodgers said Wednesday.

The proposal would make the airport unsatisfactory to both the city council and the people of Dallas, he said.

Meanwhile Nathan Adams, chairman of the master plan airport committee, called a special meeting of that group with the city council Friday to consider the proposal and determine finally whether Dallas will participate.
