

Card dated June 22, 1944 from Amon, Jr., addressed to  
Miss Dorothy Morrison, 23 Flint Street, Asheville, N.C.,

"Dear Dorothy, Many thanks for your letter which I received today.  
Sure hope you keep writing and don't forget a snapshot. Major  
Malless wrote me. about you. I have been a prisoner for 17 months  
and we now have 500 officers in this camp. Life never changes here,  
so you can see how we have a very boring existence. I spend  
most of my time reading, studying and thinking of what I'll  
do when I get back to Texas. So long for now and I 'm hoping  
to hear from you soon, Always, Amon."
