\$211.61 contributed!

That represents the amount of Will Rogers Memorial Commission funds on hand at Midland up to 2 o'clock this afternoon, two days before the nationwide campaign closes.

Committeemen had reported to Arnon G. Carter early in the week that the fund had passed the \$200 mark and it was hoped the final figure would be at least \$250.

James R. Record, associate chairman for Texas, replying to the report, said:

"That was a dandy report to Mr. Carter yesterday and all of us appreciate the efforts you have put forward in behalf of the campaign.

"We hope you pass the \$250 mark as other points are not responding like West Texas."
