I am transmitting you herewith a report on the Will Rogers Memorial Fund collections in San Antonio, the total being \$1,228.97, contributed by approximately 4,410 people. Of this amount \$100.00 was contributed by R. W. Morrison, and was included in the amount transmitted through the Alamo National Bank.

I have also requested the banks to transmit to Mr. Yarbrough any small balance of the reported subscriptions which they still hold.

I regret very much that we could not collect a greater sum than this, but earnest endeavors on the part of a number of people, including the members of the Junior Chamber of Commerce, did not bring the desired results.

We were greatly handicapped in this matter by the plans first set up by the National Organization and the publicity which came out from it from time to time.

I am particularly regretful of the poor results shown here on account of the interest which Mr. Amon G. Carter has had in this matter.
