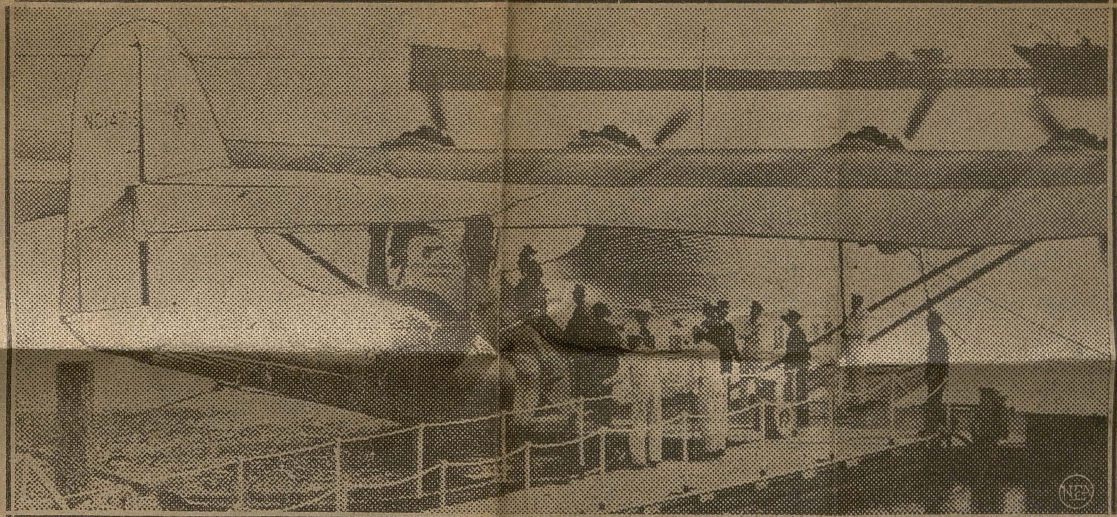

**Off to Manila on Clipper 'Preview' Hop**
