The resignation of Anson G. Carter, owner of the Fort Worth Star Telegram-Record as a member of the board of directors of the Texas Technological College, was requested by Governor Ferguson on the charge of intoxication and unbecoming conduct in cheering for the A. & M. College team at College Station Thursday and for Dan Moody in her presence (while in that condition) claiming that in doing so he set such an example before a student body unbefitting one as head of such a board. Mr. Carter says he "didn't dun it" except as to cheering for the parties above mentioned, which he claimed he had a right to, and refuses to resign as a member of the Tech. board. His reply is a voluminous one, denying all charges, and deals with "Gov. Jim" with hands free of any glove coverings.
