"AMON CARTER WELL REQUESTS 100 CIGARS MONTHLY"

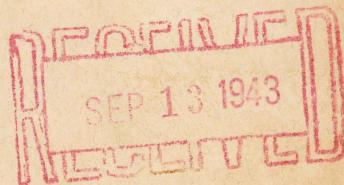
We know that you will be happy to have news of this visit, and we are glad to be able to send it along to you.
