RALPH E. STONE (Fort Worth)—*Honorary Doctor of Divinity Degree.* Associate Minister of University Christian Church and Disciple Campus Minister at TCU, he joined the Fort Worth church's staff as part-time minister to students after earning the B.A. degree in 1950 and on a full-time basis when he completed the B.D. degree through Brite Divinity School in 1954. He held a Danforth Campus Christian Worker grant while pursuing the Master of Sacred Theology degree in psychiatry and religion at Union Theological Seminary in New York.

Well-known author of religious dramas, his works include "Church on the Move," "The Junior High Camp," three one-act plays entitled "Circus, Parable, Construction" and a musical, "The Hippo's Tale." He has been producer of dramas for the Texas State Youth Convention, Fort Worth Christian Youth Council and other state and national conventions of the Christian Churches. He serves as director of "The Hypocrites," a University Christian Church drama group, and director of summer drama programs in public parks for ghetto-area youth.
