Dear Mr. Milam:

On my return to the City after a protracted absence in connection with the Rogers Memorial fund I found your letter of October 5th, making inquiry regarding the work and how the fund is being raised. I trust you will accept my apology for not sooner acknowledging your letter.

Meantime, I spent about two weeks in New York with Will Hays, Owen D. Young of the General Electric Company, and Jesse Jones, during which time we worked out the final national organization. Everything is set for opening the campaign on November 4th. The handling of the State of Oklahoma has been left entirely to Governor Marland as Honorary Chairman. He in turn will appoint an active chairman and then secure a chairman for each city throughout the state. Meanwhile, I have accepted the chairmanship for Texas and appointed 35 vice-chairmen who in turn will either act as chairmen of their city or appoint someone else to handle the work.

Enclosed is a copy of the list of committees in the national setup. I feel sure the campaign is going to be a real success.
