SUMMER AND 1943-44 SCHEDULE

Summer 1943

Instead of the usual 12 weeks divided into two terms of six weeks each, this Summer's work will be offered in two terms - the first four weeks in length and the second eight weeks in length:

First Term - May 31 to June 29  
Second Term - July 1 to August 26

Session of 1943-44

In carrying forward our regular liberal arts program and at the same time giving full cooperation to the Navy college training plan, the following schedule is being announced beginning July 1, 1943:

First Term - 16 weeks - July 1 to Oct. 30  
Second Term - 16 weeks - Nov. 1 to Feb. 29  
Third Term - 16 weeks - Mar. 1 to June 23

This is in keeping with the accelerated college program which has now been in operation for some time and will enable a Freshman to enter July 1 and to complete the regular degree requirements in less than three years.

A SPECIAL TERM ARRANGEMENT

For students who prefer to enter in September a short term of six weeks is being scheduled to begin September 20, approximately the normal opening time, and closing October 30, at which time the schedule will fall in with the regular 16 weeks term plan.
