Dear Mr. Carter:

After our telephone conversation I had a long talk to Mr. Quattrocchi. The enclosed letter is the result.


He has covered all the details you wished to know in regard to the bronze the reinforcement. The price is as I gave you, in my letter of July 19. As to the packing, it is a bit higher than the packing on the original but again the present cost of labor and equipment necessitates this increase. His request for the payments is in line with the previous payments made him ( three payments divided equally and paid at the start of work, the middle, and the completion). I hope this information is what you wanted and I, of course will keep an eye on things as I promised.

Now, about the storage. I talked to the woman with whom the model has been stored and she confirms my figures, letter of July 19, on the storage. A check to her direct or if you wish to her, addressed to me and I will take care of its delivery, will release the model. The amount four hundred dollars (\$400.00) pays the storage in full to September 15. Her name Alice Mac Monnies, McAlpin Hotel, New York City. If as you said, you wish to send Mr. Quattrocchi's checks to me and have me see that he gets them, I will do so.

You said that you want an inscription on the base. This can be worked right into the bronze, like Electra's signature and can be placed anywhere you wish. May I suggest that it be placed either next to Electra's signature or on the opposite side of the base in approximately the same spot. Please let me know just what you wish inscribed and where. Also we will need to have full shipping information.


If there are any further questions, I will be most happy to try and answer them.
