

Dean Leftwich will make two talks before the Y. M. C. A. and Y. W. C. A. Retreat to be held at the North Texas State Teachers' College in Denton this week-end. Friday he will speak on "Youth and World Problems." Sunday afternoon he will have as his subject "Race Prejudice and the College Student."

The classes in "Social Control," "Social Anthropology," and "Criminology" under the direction of Dr. Smith and Prof. Baker have given thirty-two books on sociology to the library.

The social committee for next year has been selected. Dean Beckham is chairman. Others on the committee are: Mrs. Cahoon, Prof. Ballard, Mrs. Murphy and Dean Leftwich. The committee is planning to confer with the social committees and officers of the various classes as soon as these are elected. The purpose of this conference is that social activities may be started as soon as school begins next year. At least part of the affairs to be given the first semester will be planned.

"We are hoping that the senior class of next year will see fit to give a play," said Dean Beckham. "This will start a tradition that the following classes will keep up. The junior class has always given a play and the freshmen and sophomores have their play contest and we think it would be a fine thing for the seniors to give a play for the school."

For the first time in the history of the school the president will entertain the senior class with a breakfast on June 2 in the University dining room. This will be quite informal and will make for a spirit of fellowship that any other entertainment would lack, according to Dean Beckham.

The Ex-Students and Alumni Association, the Mothers' Club and the Woman's Club will sponsor a luncheon for the ex-students and alumni to be given June 2 at either The Texar or The Blackstone. The exact place and time will be announced later.

The freshman class, which is sponsored by Miss Spragins, will entertain the school with a lawn party on Monday, May 19. The faculty and entire student body are invited.

The Registrar's Office will appreciate a return of the petition sheets of the next year's seniors that were sent out to the heads of the departments some time ago. A number of them have been returned, but some of them are still out. The office is planning to send the petition sheets to the first minor departments as soon as they are all in.
