CARTER REFUSES ACCEPT REQUEST

Fort Worth, Dec. 1.—Amon G. Carter this afternoon in a public statement, refused to accede to the request of Governor Ferguson for his resignation as chairman of the board of directors of the Texas Technological college, taking Ferguson to task and referring throughout to Ferguson and "Governor Jim." Carter says the governor's statement is malicious and without justification. He says that the story he was under the influence of drink at the Aggie-T. U. game was untrue and without foundation. He concludes by saying he will continue as chairman, Governor Jim and the highway commission to the contrary notwithstanding.
