Dear Mr. Gill:

Your letter to James R. Record regarding the matter of having Will Rogers in Beaumont has been turned over to me and I am writing Jesse Jones as per the enclosed copy inasmuch as Jesse has charge of Rogers program in Houston.

I have suggested that he work out a plan for Rogers to go to Beaumont for a matinee program from two to four o'clock and then fill his night engagement in Houston. Otherwise, there would be no opportunity to take care of you inasmuch as he has eleven towns to play in six days: Austin, San Antonio, Abilene, San Angelo, Brock- enridge, Dallas, Houston, Wichita Falls, Fort Worth, Mineral Wells and Waco and he will return here Sunday morning and go through to Oklahoma, where he has a similar program laid out for Oklahoma. The week following he has a similar program for Arkansas. I would suggest that you get in touch with Jesse immediately.
