Dear Sir,

I have just recently returned from Germany where I was in Oflag 64 and knew Lt. Carter. I just thought that you would like to hear from me and know that he is alright and in fine health. He receives his mail very good and all parcels go through fine. His job in the camp is to take care of all mail and parcels.

The camp is the best one in Germany but still it could be better. We get Red Cross parcels each week which gives us most of our food. We make all of our own entertainment and have a library of about five thousand books.

If there is anything that you would like to know about the camp or Lt. Carter I will tell you all I can if you will let me know.
