I got an aerial photograph a few months ago, with your help, to show a circular formation about 0.3 mile wide at the point marked with a + on the attached map, No. CRI 2V 177.

This was just what I wanted and showed the formation well. I am now wondering if this is likewise shown on one of the adjoining sheets, as I would like to get that for a stereographic view.

If you can consult your general map and give me the number of an adjoining sheet that also shows this geological formation I would again be grateful for the accommodation.

If what I am asking for is available, I would also like a set of the order sheets so that I can buy the map. The geologists call this a sink formation, but I am interested in it as a possible "crypto-explosion" crater, maybe caused ages ago by a meteorite.
