The Provost Marshal General directs me to inform you that the German and Italian governments have refused to permit tobacco and tobacco products to be included in next of kin parcels to American prisoners of war. However, special arrangements have been made with several tobacco companies whereby tobacco products may be mailed by tobacco companies direct to officially reported American prisoners of war in Europe, when place of internment is known.

There is inclosed for your possible use two tobacco labels with a blank order form attached. Should you desire to use these labels select the company you desire, properly fill in the order and forward it direct to the tobacco company with a postal money order for the proper amount of your purchase. Each label must be used within the date stamped thereon and each label will permit the sending of three cartons of cigarettes or its equivalent in cigars, smoking tobacco or chewing tobacco. You will note that the prices charged are exclusive of internal revenue taxes as arrangements have been made whereby these items may be forwarded without the payment of taxes or postage. The tobacco companies have agreed to pack such tobacco products as you may order and mail the package direct from the factory to the prisoner of war using the inclosed label.


The list of tobacco companies, the products they sell and the prices charged for each unit is shown below. Please note that a unit consists of three cartons of cigarettes or one hundred cigars, or twenty-four ounces of smoking tobacco unless stated otherwise or twenty-four ounces of chewing tobacco unless stated otherwise. Each order attached to the label must be used for one unit of either three cartons of cigarettes or its equivalent in other kinds of tobacco. In other words smoking tobacco may not be included in the same package with cigars. Units cannot be divided. The tobacco companies are selling their products at cost. Your cooperation in strictly following these instructions is requested. Please do not ask that exceptions be made and that units be divided.
