Dear Mr. Kemp:

In line with your request when I called on you the other day, I am sending you a copy of the last letter from Secretary Jones. This was in answer to my letter of November 10, copy of which is also enclosed, and messages from Mr. Carter in which he called attention of the Secretary to the favorable comment in his letter of November 1 to Mayor Rodgers in regard to the "North Central" location. You will note that in his message of November 11 to Mr. Carter he specifically states that neither the Department nor the Civil Aeronautics Administration had decided anything concerning the location of the buildings. That was also confirmed by my conversation with Mr. Stanton last week.

In connection with the letter, estimates and sketch prepared by the City which I left with you the other day, you may be interested in having copy of my letter of December 3 to Mr. Stanton telling him that we were preparing such sketches of layout of the airport. This, I believe, brings the record up to date.
