Dear Mr. Carter:

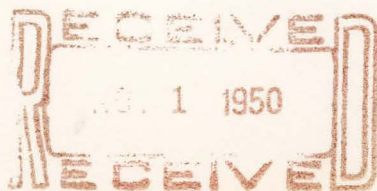
I have just received a letter from the Hotel Texas stating that you paid my room rent and board while I was there.
