Dear Mr. Carter:

TAKE NOTICE that the Special Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Air Power League, originally called for February 3rd, 1945, has been adjourned to 2 P.M. on March 22, 1945 and will then be held, on the 48th Floor of 570 Lexington Avenue, New York, N.Y.

In addition to the purposes for which said meeting was originally called, there will also come before the adjourned meeting a proposal that Section 3 of Article I of the By-laws be amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. General Membership and Dues: The membership shall be divided into the following classes and annual dues of the respective classes shall be as follows:

<u>Class of Membership</u>	<u>Annual Dues</u>
senior	One hundred dollars
Sustaining	Twenty-five dollars
Contributing	Ten dollars
Regular	Five dollars
Ex-Service	Three dollars.

Ex-Service Membership shall be open only to persons who shall have served in the armed forces of the United States.

A Member may change the class of his membership by delivering to an Officer of the League a written notice which shall specify the new class of his selection, and any dues then or thereafter by such Member shall be those appropriate to such new class."
