Dear Mr. Carter,

My husband, Lt. Henry L. Pritchett, Jr., is a prisoner of war and was transferred to Oflag 64 in August. He has mentioned in several of his letters that Amon, Jr., is one of his roommates "and a good guy." Henry has written twice for his father (Dr. H.D. Pritchett of S.M.U.) and me to contact you.

We cannot tell whether Henry is trying to tell us that you might have some information about the camp that we do not have, or if he merely wants us to tell you again that your son is well and has many friends there in the camp.

If it is that you know more about the activities in Oflag 64 than is published in the Red Cross Bulletin, Dr. Pritchett and I should greatly appreciate an interview at your convenience. And anything more Henry writes about Amon, Jr., will be relayed to you. They seem to be quite well taken care of there.
