Further referring to Private Melvin J. Brewer, I am in receipt of an additional report from the War Department, relative to his case, which I hand you herewith.

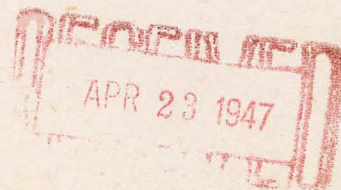

Permit me to make further reference to the interest you have expressed in Private Melvin J. Brewer, 6954524, concerning whose case I wrote you on April 8, 1947.

I am now informed that Private Brewer has been transferred from Camp Kilmer, New Jersey, to the Detachment of Patients, Valley Forge General Hospital, Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, for further observation and treatment.

As I have previously advised you, the record of Private Brewer's trial by general court-martial is now under consideration by a Board of Review in the Office of The Judge Advocate General as required by the statutes of the United States. I shall be pleased to follow this matter through and keep you informed as to further developments in this case.
