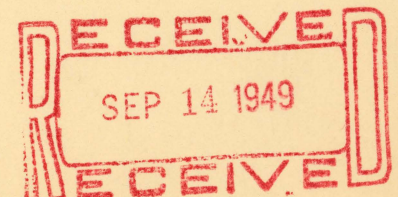
If that date is not suitable, we could come the following week, but we should like to be there before October 1st, as several things are slated here that need our attention.
