My son was taken in Italy
and was at Oflag 64 until the
Russians got close and then he
was taken (I believe walked) to
Stalag 3A - I have been informed
by Lieutenant Harry Abrams, who escaped,
that our sons were, together -

When you write your son will
you ask him as to whether he
knew Lieutenant Donald T. Rutz and if so
what became of him -

The War Dept tells me that their
latest information is Oflag 64 - but
that the prisoners from there were moved
but that is all they know.

Tomorrow my daughter-in-law received
a card from him at Stalag 3A. dated
February 10 - but nothing since -

However it was reported on the radio about February 15th that this man in Stalag 3A. able to work has been taken to Southern Germany -

I know that a number of his friends escaped from Oflag but of course they know nothing as to more recent happenings.

You can imagine that his mother and I are rather anxious to get some word from our son.

Thanking you in advance for your courtesy and trouble in the matter and hoping your boy will be home shortly I am
