I'm writing this letter rather hurriedly so it can get in this morning's mail, so it will be rather brief. I haven't much to say anyhow.

I will be re-enlisted tomorrow for foreign service, Philippine Department and will leave for home tomorrow evening or Wednesday morning.

Therefore I will be there on either the second or third of August if the bus lines run according to schedule.
