Press reports and radio broadcasts on one hand say that American Prisoners of War at Oflag 64, Germany, have been released and on the other that they have been moved into Central Germany from the Polish corridor to prevent their being taken by the Russians PERIOD My son is a prisoner of war in Oflag 64 together with many other Texans and we are exceedingly anxious to ascertain any information you whereabouts may be able to give us as to the whereabouts of these American Officers in Oflag 64 or any other Camps. Please advise by wire or telephone collect 3-2301.
