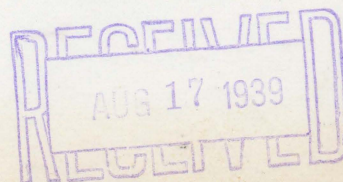

In consideration of The Franklin D. Roosevelt Library, Inc. entering my name in its official records as one of its Associates, I promise, on behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to pay to The Franklin D. Roosevelt Library, Inc., as and when called for by the Treasurer thereof, and in any event on or before May 15, 1940, a sum equal to one seventieth (1/70th) of the difference between the amount of money raised and paid into The Franklin D. Roosevelt Library, Inc., during the period of the public campaign from January 1, 1939, up to and including November 1, 1939, and \$350,000, which payment on my part shall not exceed in any event the sum of \$5,000 provided, however, that any gift made by me to said Franklin D. Roosevelt Library, Inc. shall be credited against said payment to be made by me.
