Dear Amon:

Thanks very much for your invitation to come to Fort Worth on Tuesday, November 4, to attend the unveiling of the Will Rogers Equestrian Monument at the Will Rogers Memorial Coliseum. I mentioned to Mrs. Donnell the privilege I had of meeting Mrs. Carter in New York last Friday, and what a delightful person she was. She immediately wanted to know if there wasn't some way we could arrange to go to Fort Worth for this occasion but I told her it was absolutely out of the question. I just had to say no for several reasons. We have some important Company matters coming up at that time and, also, I am still operating on quite a restricted schedule which denies me the privilege of traveling as much as I would like.

It is with sincere regret that we are going to be denied the privilege of being present in the Will Rogers Memorial Coliseum to hear Dwight D. Eisenhower, General of the Army, dedicate this monument.
