Your letter to Amon Carter, Jr., has been received in which you ask him to write you and in the event he should come to Mexico to throw any clothes he has no use for in a bag and bring them to you.

Lt. Amon Carter, Jr., has been in the service for two years. He trained at Fort Knox for a year then was stationed in Ireland and England several months and moved to Africa where he was in action in the Tunisian area and taken prisoner by the Germans. He is now interned in a "prisoner of War" camp in Germany.

Naturally, he will be unable to write you until the war is over and he is returned home.
