Your letter of March 19 received and I appreciate the sentiment expressed therein. I can well imagine your anxiety over your son who is in combat with General Patton's Army, and I hope that he will come through in good shape.

My son is still a prisoner of war insofar as I know. There have been newspaper reports as well as information to some of the families of boys who were in the same prison camp as my son, that their kin have been released; however, two months have lapsed now and I feel confident that he was not among those who were liberated at the time of the Russian advance through Poland.
