This news may have already reached you.

We is a son of Mr. and Mrs. John S. Erwin of this city, distributor of the Gulf Oil Company's petroleum products and incidentally my successor for the Texas election Bureau reporting for many years past.

In as much as communications from those in prison camps seem to be limited it has occurred that John might pass on any such news to you that has been received by them and thereby hear oftener from Amon.

We have been much interested in Amon Jr. as he and my younger son, Dr. Jas. L. Johnson, now Intern in St. Joseph's Hospital of your city, were rather well acquainted with each other at the University of Texas.
