My dear Mr. Thomas:

The attached statement on "Total Compensation Paid to Military and Civilian Employees Engaged in Public Relations and Publicity Activities for the Fiscal Year 1949" is submitted in response to your request of June 30, 1950, to which was attached the letter of Mr. Bascom N. Timmons, returned herewith.

This same information was furnished the House Committee on Appropriations last December in response to their request. However, data on the number of persons engaged on a full-time or part-time basis were not obtained, and it would entail considerable research work in some agencies to fulfill such a request at this late date. It is fair to assume, from previous reported experience, that a good portion of the cost is represented by part-time services of either full-time or part-time employees.

I realize that this does not provide all the information desired; however, it is the most we can provide from currently available data.
