Dear Mr. Carter:

As you have probably been informed, the Airport Advisory Committee is meeting in Kansas City March 10th, 11th and 12th.

I would appreciate it if you would advise me as to your arrival date so that I may personally take care of your hotel reservation and meet you on your arrival.

This will probably be the most serious meeting which the Committee has ever had. There is ample evidence that both airports and airlines are facing a crisis. In my opinion, the theme of this meeting should be aviation cooperation in a fight for the very preservation of the air transportation industry. Actions of Congress and others in Washington have threatened the economic life of the airport, as well as the economic life of the air transportation companies.

I speak on behalf of Mr. Curry and the entire Committee when I earnestly urge you to give us as much time as possible in helping to formulate a future constructive program. The urgency of the situation is well recognized and I can assure you that the whole Committee will appreciate your presence.
