YOU ARE FAMILIAR WITH PROBLEMS INVOLVED IN FINANCING THE ACCESS ROAD TO THE CONVAIR PLANT IN FORT WORTH. IN MY OPINION IT WOULD BE DISASTROUS TO THE BEST INTERESTS OF OUR CITIZENS AND TO THE NATIONAL DEFENSE EFFORT TO TURN THE EXTREMELY HEAVY CONVAIR TRAFFIC LOOSE AND UNCONTROLLED UPON THE RIDGLEA AREA UNDER THE PLANS NECESSARY WITH THE PRESENT FINANCING.
