Neither the Department of Commerce nor the Civil Aeronautics Administration has decided anything in connection with the Midway Airport except the location of the runways. These have been located or projected according to the plan sent to you, the Mayor of Dallas and all other interested parties. The Administration Building will not be erected until after the Armed Services turn the field back to private operators. It will then be the responsibility of those who join in the operation of the airport to determine the location of the Administration Building and pay for its erection. It is my hope that one of the two sites on Highway 183 will prove to be acceptable to both Fort Worth and Dallas.
