Dear Betty: Please accept my apology for not sooner acknowledging the sweetest letter I have ever received from anyone. Frankly, I have devoted practically all of my time to the memorial for Will since I left California including ten days in New York with Owen D. Young, Jesse Jones, Will Hays, Trubee Davison and others. We finally prevailed on Eddie Rickenbacker to take the directorship and am acting as chairman in Texas. We are trying to get everything organized for a national setup and I feel we shall be successful notwithstanding it is a tremendous and responsible job STOP It is not a matter of the willingness of the public to contribute to this most worthy cause on the part of Will's friends. On the contrary it is merely a matter of getting the organization lined up and in action whereby the public will have a full opportunity to express their love and affection for Will in connection with the memorial idea STOP It is hard for me to realize that sweet old Will has left us. Somehow I still feel he is merely away on a trip and I am sure this same memory lives in the hearts of the American public. I further realize more so every day, if possible, the great loss that you, his family and friends have sustained and I want you to know that I am subject to your call at any time on anything your heart may desire STOP Mrs. Roosevelt was here for three days and we discussed you and Will frequently STOP When you go East I hope it will be possible for you to come through Fort Worth. Please tell Oscar Lawler that I have not forgotten him. It would have done your heart good to have been present at the meetings held in New York and realize the feeling and sentiment which prompted these busy men to sacrifice their own business out of their love and affection for Will.
